# Vocabulary

- Know all letter sounds

# Vocabulary

Capitals, periods- students should understand that each sentence should include a Capital and ending punctuation

#### Concepts

- Write 3 or more sentences on one topic
- Write 3 events in order

#### Vocabulary

- Addition- to join two or more numbers to get a total(sum)
- Subtraction-taking one quantity away from a larger quantity

#### Concepts

- Count to 120 by 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's
- Read and write numbers to 120

### Vocabulary

Saving- put away money for wants and needs.

#### Concepts

understanding the difference between needs and wants

# Talk with your child about Museums Manners:

- waiting our turn to speak in conversations
- answer questions in a complete sentence

- not touching exhibits
